Asset Recording Services provides an edited video of home interior and exterior of all structures on the premise. We list electronics, appliances and other items by model- and serial-number and pair still image with description and any receipts or certificates of valuation within an updatable software program which allows the homeowner to maintain current inventory of acquisitions. In addition to the inventory manifest, we affix owner identification labels inconspicuously to items that may be subject to theft. The insurer may require this should stolen property be recovered, the property would be identified and returned to the owner, making a claim unnecessary. The complete inventory package meets/exceeds insurer's requirements to document a future claim for loss or damage and ensures prompt processing and claim satisfaction at the fullest extent of coverage.
